

**Local Law 93 of 2015 (Previously Local Law 6 of 2011) – Biannual Report**

Pursuant to Local Law 93 of 2015, the Department of Education is required to provide reports on student discipline data (suspension data) to the City Council twice a year (October 31 and March 31). The October reporting requires citywide suspension data by month for the second half of the academic year, January through June. Per the legislation and in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), any value from zero (0) to five (5) has been redacted.

Data from January – June 2016, when compared to the same time period last year, January – June 2015, shows a decrease of 4.1% in total suspensions. Principal suspensions decreased by 6% and superintendent suspensions increased by 1%.

In school year 2015-16, when comparing the full school year (September 2015 to June 2016), we saw a decrease of 15.6% in total suspensions with principal suspensions decreasing by 19.7% and superintendent suspensions decreasing by 3.2%.

In addition, pursuant to Local Law 93 of 2015, the Department of Education is required to provide the total number of EMS transports and the number of EMS transports performed because of a student’s psychological/emotional condition to City Council twice a year (October 31 and March 31). The October reporting requires EMS data disaggregated by district and by month for the second half of the school year (January to June). Per the legislation and in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), any value from zero (0) to five (5) has been redacted.
