

## 2018-19 STUDENT PERCEPTION SURVEY ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

### Teachers are eligible if:

- ✓ For schools administering to ONE class per teacher:  
Teachers of grades 6-12 have at least 10 students present in one or two class periods. If they cannot meet this 10 student minimum across two classes, they are not eligible.
- ✓ For schools administering to TWO classes per teacher:  
Teachers of grades 6-12 have at least 10 students present in one or two classes. If the teacher cannot meet this 10 student minimum across two classes, they can administer the survey to students in up to four class periods, or whatever is feasible for them to meet the 10 student minimum.
- ✓ For District 75, they teach students in grades 6-12 who are in a 12:1:1 class and who take standardized assessments.

Note: In September, principals selected to administer to one or two classes per teacher for the Student Perception Survey. If no selection was made, schools were defaulted to one class per teacher. Your school's selected preferences can be found in the "2018-19 Student Perception Survey Preferences" file on the Student Perception Survey website at [StudentPerceptionSurvey.nyc](http://StudentPerceptionSurvey.nyc).

### Students are eligible if:

- ✓ They are currently enrolled in grades 6-12.
- ✓ They take standardized assessments.
- ✓ They are taught by the teacher being surveyed for at least four weeks prior to survey administration.

Note: An effort should be made to survey students who have had at least 10 class meetings with a teacher who teaches them less than five days per week.
