Any activity that responds to climate change can be climate action. Most climate actions fall into two groups:

Mitigation

Reducing heat-trapping pollution from greenhouse gases (GHGs).

Adaptation

Adapting to climate hazards, like very hot weather or storms.

Each day is based on a theme and schools will plan activities that best serve their students. They can teach students fun ways to have a positive impact or celebrate the ways they already take action.
