



Dental Visit Prep

Picking a Dental Clinic Space

DO'S

- **15' x 15' MINIMUM**
A large room is needed for dental equipment. X-rays require 6' safety zones, if using.
- **HAVE OUTLETS**
The rooms you pick should have 3-4 assessible outlets for machine plug-ins; ideally on multiple walls in room.
- **WHOLE DAY AVAILABILITY**
Dental services take time. Depending on dental services and number of students, the room might be needed for the entire school day.

DONT'S

- **HIGH TRAFFIC AREAS**
Don't pick a room with lots of traffic inside or outside the room. Privacy is key!
- **OFFICE, SMALL CLASSROOMS**
These rooms are not ideal spaces because of limited space or lack of privacy.
- **BAD LIGHTING**
Good lighting is needed for dentists to do their work. Room should be well-lit and adjustable lights.
